HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

SEAL - Socially Engaged Art Lab

- To be aware and contribute to the adequate control of all health and safety issues arising from RAW's workshop activities within schools and community group spaces, by initially discussing (risk assessment) and ensuring the safety of spaces utilised, for RAW's workshops.
- To consult with the relevant contact within the School/Community Project on matters affecting health and safety issues immediately.
- To ensure safe handling and use of materials, substances & equipment and without risk to health.
- To ensure workshops, are facilitated by competent, qualified & experienced staff.
- Ensure all staff working with RAW, have an enhanced CRB/DBS Disclosure & they are signed up to the update service.
- Refer to Schools & Community Projects health & safety policies when instructed & when appropriate.
- To review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.
- To ensure RAW is aware of the procedures/accessible adequate first aid provision (awareness - relevant protocol) on all work sites.

RAW believes it has a responsibility for the promotion of health & safety in the workspaces it utilizes. It is for this reason RAW works closely and in partnership with schools & community projects, to ensure health and safety procedures are adhered to by RAW artists at all times, respectfully and professionally.
